

## Seasonal Employment Opportunity

Winter is one of the busiest times in the production cycle at Dickman Farms. In the winter we produce millions of young plants that are shipped nationwide to other growers to be finished for spring sales.

During this period of time we hire thirty to forty seasonal and/or part time employees to accomplish a number of tasks that relate to plant production, plant maintenance and distribution.

Some of the things that our seasonal team does:

- Plant a variety of plants into trays or containers on a motorized belt in an assembly line fashion.
- Assist the shipping department in filling orders for distribution.
- Harvest cuttings from stock plants.
- Maintain the appearance of plants by pruning, weeding, removing dead foliage repairing skips, etc.
- Relocate plants from one greenhouse to another or to other designated areas.
- Maintain a neat and clean work environment by sweeping floors, removing empty trays and containers, taking out trash, and cleaning up after a specific job is completed.
- Perform miscellaneous job related duties as assigned from season to season.

Seasonal employees are hired during the time frame of December through June with the highest concentration of help being January through May. Experience is not required.

Seasonal employees must be able to sit, stand, walk, use fingers, grasp, handle, feel, push, pull, reach, stoop, kneel, crouch, bend, talk, hear and perform repetitive motions with hands and/or wrists.

If you would like to earn some extra money in the period between Christmas and school summer vacation consider applying as a seasonal employee at Dickman Farms. Many of our long term, full-time employees started their career at Dickman Farms as a seasonal employee.
