

Cyclamen

Beautiful foliage and blooms brighten any room!

The Cyclamen is a beautiful fall, winter and spring flowering plant with attractive silver marbled foliage. If cared for properly it continues to flower for 2-4 months with cool nights extending the flowering period. Flowers range in color from white to red and shades of pink, some with frilly petals.

Placement:

- Cool Room- 50-54 degrees-night temperature; 60-70 degrees-daytime temperature
- Medium to bright indirect light

Care:

- During flowering season, water when soil feels dry to the touch.
- Keep water out of the crown of the plant.
- Remove any drainage from the saucer.
- Dead and yellowing leaves should immediately be removed, as should old flower stems.
- Fertilize every two weeks during flowering period

Extended Care:

- When leaves start to yellow after flowering is finished, gradually withhold water until the corm is dormant
 - Put pot on its side in a dark, cool place until late May
 - Put pot outside in lightly shaded place until corm begins to shoot new leaves again in late July
 - Repot in soilless potting, leaving half the corm above the surface
 - Keep slightly shaded and in temperature 45-50 degrees
 - Start feeding as the leaves develop
- Bring indoors before night frosts begin
